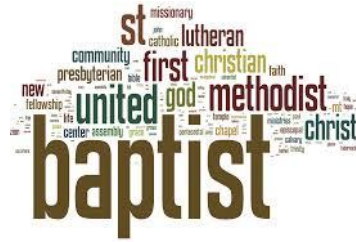


DENOMINATIONALISM IS ALWAYS **WRONG!**



6 REASONS DENOMINATIONALISM IS UNBIBLICAL:

1) It Denies That There Is “One Body”

“There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism” – Eph 4:4-5

2) It Promotes Many Gospels

“I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, ⁷ which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ.” – Gal 1:6-7

3) It Opposes Christ’s Prayer For Unity

“I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word; that they all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent Me.” – Jn 17:20-21

“Is Christ divided? Was Paul crucified for you? Or were you baptized in the name of Paul?” – I Cor 1:13

4) It Is Based Upon Doctrines That Will Be “Uprooted”

“But He answered and said, “Every plant which My heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted.” – Matt 15:13
